We cannot rely on human nature to represent God. We ALL fall short of the glory of God, so we struggle to represent him (Romans 3:23-24).

You need to learn for yourself that you are safe with God. Draw near to him so he can draw near to you (James 4:8). God is Love (1 John 4:16) Meaning being closer to him will allow you to experience more love. You are safe in God's Love (Jude 1:21, John 3:16)

God promises to deliver, heal and love us (Romans 8:35-39, Jeremiah 30:17). His grace is bigger than our sins (Romans 5:20-21). God will not let injustice prosper, especially for long (Proverbs 22:8). His Justice just looks different to how we perceive. Trust him, he will not forsake you ever (Psalm 9:10).

The Lord will keep you from all harm—he will watch over your life;


the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore.
