Betrayed by his brothers, sold into slavery, and later wrongfully imprisoned, Joseph's life was filled with pain. Yet, through these adversities, God was preparing him for a higher calling.

When Joseph became a leader in Egypt, he was able to save his family from famine, and declared, "But as for you, you meant evil against me; but God meant it for good, in order to bring it about as it is this day, to save many people alive" (Genesis 50:20).
